### 2 Corinthians 13. 11-end

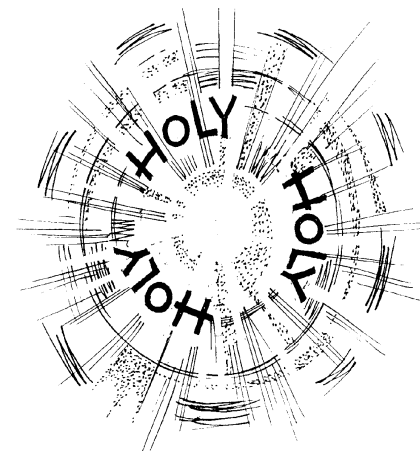
